The San Fernando Valley Flyers, AMA charter #152, is a model aviation club with a history spanning over 75 years. The club was established in the Sepulveda Basin Dam area of Southern California, which was a prime location for early aviation and home to a significant portion of the American aerospace industry by the end of World War II. In the San Fernando Valley Flyers Club, many early aviation innovations were tested via R/C models and documented in the Valley Flyers newsletter.

Today, the club focuses on promoting model aviation, maintaining the Apollo XI field, and fostering good fellowship and community relations. As a member of the San Fernando Valley Flyers, you can enjoy the educational benefits and camaraderie that come with being part of a long-standing model aviation club. Your membership also supports the club's efforts to improve the Apollo XI field and champion community relation projects.

The Apollo XI field has designated areas to fly fixed wing, helicopters, drones, control-line, and small aircraft under 2 lbs. Limit your altitude to 250 feet, or 100 feet when runway 34 is in use at Van Nuys. Stay within designated flying borders.
